NAVAJO TRANSIT SYSTEM WILL RESUME BUS SERVICES WITH A “SOFT RE-START” DATE OF JUNE 7, 2021.

DUE TO COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS, NTS WILL BE IMPLEMENTING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES FOR ITS ROUTE SERVICE.

LIMITED BUS SERVICE

Limited bus routes and limited bus stops will be implemented. Four bus routes operational: Rt 3, Rt 5, Rt 9, Rt 14. Hours of service will be from 5:00 AM to 8:00 PM Monday through Friday.



FACE COVERING REQUIRED

By Executive Order of the U.S. President under Section 5302 of Title 49, face mask are required in public transportation settings including on board bus and at bus stop locations.

ENHANCED CLEANING

NTS has implemented enhanced cleaning protocols and driver protective barriers on our buses. Hand sanitizer and masks will be available on our buses.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

All passengers will be required to practice social distancing and maintain 6 feet separation. Seating will be in designated areas only. This will reduce the seating capacity of the buses

PASSENGERS

The public is advised to not use public transit if they are feeling symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19. Use of public transit shall be limited for essential trips only.

NO BUS FARE

Bus fare will be waived for our transit service during the COVID-19 pandemic. Seats will be limited and on a first come, first served basis. When capacity is reached, no one else will board.
