



Subject: Suspension of Transit services

On Friday March 13, 2020, the Navajo Nation President Jonathan Nez and Vice President Myron Lizer ordered a temporary closure of the Navajo Nation Government offices as a preventative measure against the COVID-19 Virus in the Navajo Nation.

The Navajo Transit System (NTS), Division of General Services, shall suspend all route operations, in accordance with the Navajo Nation President's Executive Order and all non-essential staff shall work remotely from home beginning Tuesday March 17, 2020 until such time that it is deemed safe to resume public transportation services. This is to prevent potential spread of the COVID-19 virus.

Further, Navajo Transit System will have staff in the office during normal business hours to take calls and answer questions but office will be closed to the public. Navajo Transit System shall utilize this time to thoroughly clean equipment, vehicles and offices.

Navajo Transit System shall also notify Federal Transit Administration, New Mexico Department of Transportation and Arizona Department of Transportation of this imposed suspension of operations. Navajo Transit System shall post appropriate notices for the public.

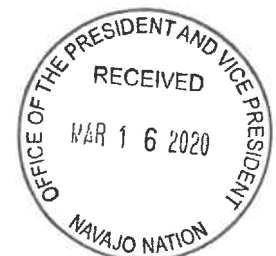
